- Opportunity to buy plants
- Facilities are available

Set your satnav for WA4 4HP or follow the directions below:  
Turn left onto A54. Keep left to continue on Chester Rd/A556. Turn left onto Forest Rd/A49. Continue to follow A49. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit and stay on A49 for 2.6 miles. Turn left onto Northwich Rd/A533, after 1.3 miles turn left onto Lodge Lane. Destination will be on the right.

Parking: There is plenty of free car parking available for visitors. Disabled visitors are welcome to park at the top of the track, next to the tea room.
